The 2003 Blue jay boys' volleyball team finished its regular season with a record of 14-4, the best record in the twelve year history of the program. Going into the District VI championships, the Blue jays were seeded third.

In the quarterfinal round of playoffs on May 21st, the Jays knocked off Central Martinsburg in two straight games, 15-7, 15-4. The semi-finals and finals were played at Altoona high school on May 24th. Conemaugh Valley faced second-seeded Altoona in the semifinal round and came out on top, 15-12, 10-15, 15-11.

The District VI final pitted Conemaugh Valley against previously undefeated State College. The two teams battled back and forth to 13-13. The Jays went up 14-13 on a solo block by Adam Cobaugh and went on to win 17-15. Game two was another barnburner, with Conemaugh Valley coming out on top 15-13, to take the game, match, and the first District title in the program's history. Richard Hinton had twenty-six service points for the two matches and Cobaugh added 18. Middle blocker Tyler Ribblett led the offense with 30 kills in the day.

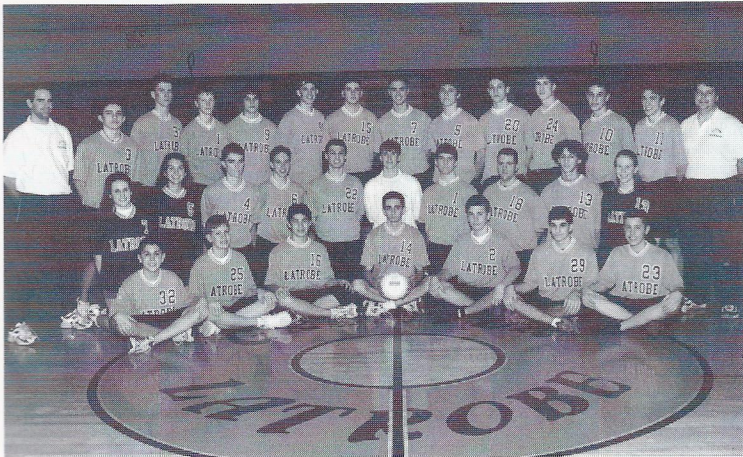

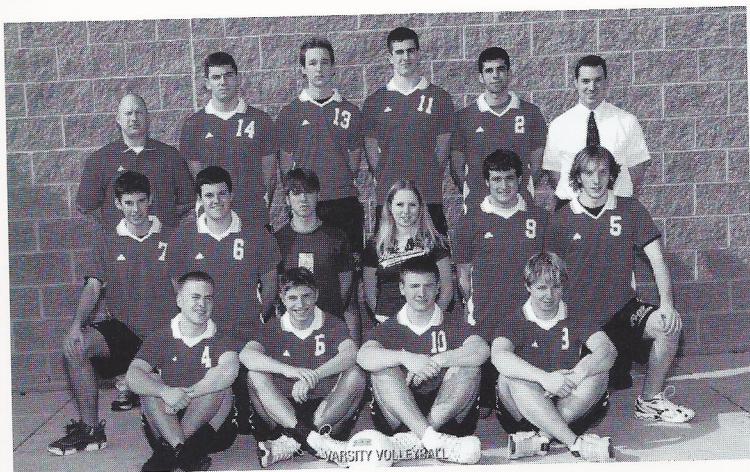

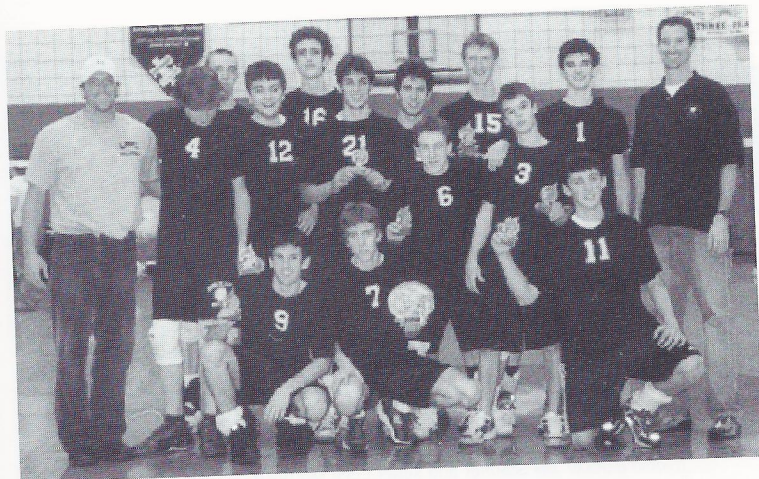
In only its 9th Season as a varsity sport the Eagles are 157-40 (overall matches) and 536-230 (overall games). Exeter has won the Berks League Division 1 Championship 6 times and has been in the last 7 of 8 Berks League Championships winning 4 titles.

Exeter has qualified for the District 3 Tournament 7 times in the last 8 years. EHSVB has won 82 out of its last 84 regular season League matches, winning 58 straight at one point.
